  - 6. If you could change something about a character in the story, what would it be and why? Why did you choose this character?
  - 7. I wish the author would change this part because...
  - 8. Why do you think the author wrote this novel/story? What message do you think the author is trying to share?
  - Write a summary of what you read today.
  - 10. This character/situation reminds me of a similar character/situation in my own life. Explain the connection.
  - 11. The ideas here remind me of the ideas in (another book, movie, news event) because...
  - 12. I think this will happen next/soon (identify characters, events, etc.) because...
